

Final Science Fair Participation Reminder

To Students and Parents of Students in Andrew Cooke's Science Fair. Here are the rules and information that you need to have a successful science fair experience.

RULES:

1. The fair will not provide access to electricity, gas, or water.
2. Do not bring animals, fire, foods, or liquids of any kind to the science fair. Bring photos instead.
3. The fair cannot be responsible for any loss of items. We advise that students should not display laptops or other items of value.
4. You must remove your project at the end of the expo. We do not have storage space for unclaimed projects.
5. You must have a sturdy display board. They are available on a first come first serve basis for \$3.00 from Mr. Freer.

DROPPING OFF PROJECTS:

Drop off projects on the morning of Thursday, February 16th, 2012 between 6:00 – 8:00 AM.

Make sure to bring the following, if your child completed them:

1. Display board
2. Any items that go in front of the display board
3. Pen, tape, glue, and other quick-fix items in case the display board gets damaged in transit.
4. Copy of Final report

VISITING THE FAIR:

Parents and other family members are welcome to visit the fair between 9:30 and 2:30 on Thursday, February 16th, 2012. We highly recommend that you visit the fair to give students the chance to feel proud of showing their work.

REMOVING PROJECTS:

You must remove projects by 5:00 on Thursday, February 16th, 2012. The school does not have space for the storage of projects.
